MAKE YOUR VOICE HEARD ON **NOVEMBER 3, 2020**

## VOTE EARLY FROM HOME



- 1) With a MI drivers license or state ID, request your ballot online at [michigandems.com/onlineavapp](https://michigandems.com/onlineavapp) and have it mailed to you.
- 2) You can also download and print an absentee ballot application from [michigandems.com/avapp](https://michigandems.com/avapp) and mail it or drop it off or at your city/township clerk. Your ballot will be mailed to you.
- 3) Vote your ballot, sign the envelope, and mail it to your local clerk or drop it off at their office or designated drop box. Your clerk must receive the ballot by 8 PM on Tuesday, November 3, 2020 for it to be counted.

## VOTE EARLY AT CLERK'S OFFICE STARTING SEPTEMBER 24, 2020



- 1) Go to your city/township clerk's office, register to vote if you aren't already, and get an absentee ballot application by 4 PM on Monday, November 2, 2020. Find your clerk's address and hours at [michigandems.com/clerk](https://michigandems.com/clerk).
- 2) Fill out the application, give it to the staff, and receive your ballot.
- 3) Vote your ballot, sign the envelope, and submit it as directed by the staff.
